Ephesians 2:11-16

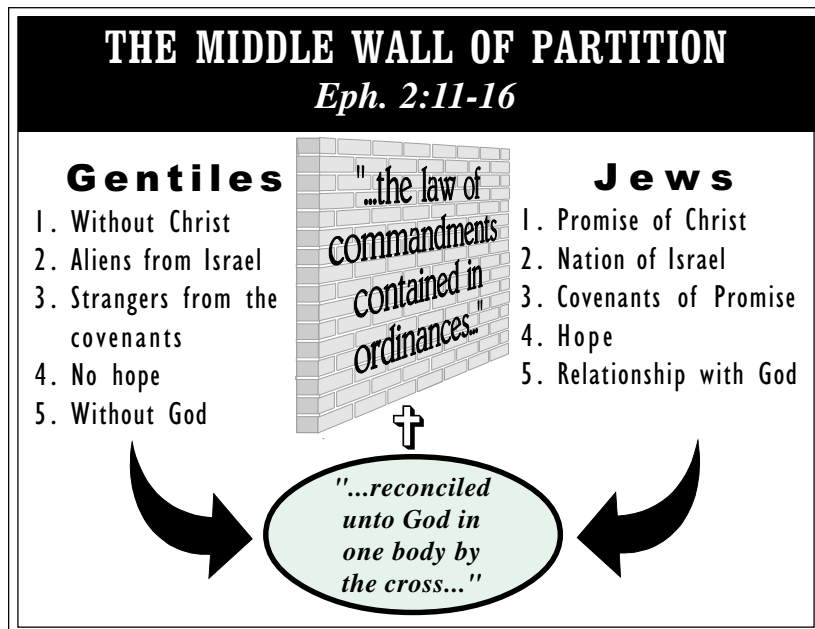
- True or False** ▶ At one time, the Jews and Gentiles had been separated and alienated from one another by a “middle wall of partition.”
- True or False** ▶ The “middle wall of partition” and “enmity” that separated the Jews and Gentiles was the “law of commandments” or Law of Moses.

1 Timothy 1:3-4; 2 Timothy 1:13

- True or False** ▶ Paul told Timothy it was okay if some people taught different doctrines.
- Yes - No** ▶ Did Paul say that there is a "form (pattern) of sound words" that we are to hold to?
(*form - pattern; figure*)

Acts 1:2; 10:42; 17:30

- Yes - No** ▶ Does God teach us today by direct commandments in the Bible?

Colossians 2:13-17

- Yes - No** ▶ Did Jesus "blot out the handwriting of ordinances" and "nail it to His cross"?
- Yes - No** ▶ If the Law of Moses has been "abolished" and "nailed to the cross", should we judge others by it today?

Romans 7:4-7

Colossians 3:17; Acts 4:5-10

True or False ▶We do not have to do all things today "in the name of Jesus Christ."

True or False ▶To do something "in the name of Christ" means to do it by His authority, or in keeping with His will.

True or False ▶To do "all things in the name of the Lord" means that we must literally say "in Jesus' name" every time we do something.

Hebrews 1:1-2; John 12:48-50

True or False ▶I will be judged by the words of Jesus Christ rather than by the words of Moses and the prophets.
